Overview

Algebra permeates all mathematical thinking from the very earliest counting blocks to mathematical genius. This course identifies the very earliest algebraic activities that are happening on a daily basis in our classrooms. From these first steps to mastery this course provides ideas and resources to build effective learning pathways in algebra.

Aims

Ensure our pupils are suitably equipped for the challenges of the new National Curriculum.

- Demystify algebra at EYFS/KS1/KS2 by recognising that “algebra” is taught even before a child begins school.
- Build on these early algebraic experiences throughout EYFS, KS1 and KS2
- Have an understanding of the value of algebra to pupils and how this fits with a “mastery” approach.
- Equip teachers with pedagogical knowledge of delivering algebra effectively using Bruner’s theory—concrete, pictorial, abstract (CPA)
- Share ideas and resources to promote effective teaching and learning in algebra
